This half term, we have been focusing on the book 'A Way Home for Wolf' by Rachel Bright. The children have really enjoyed meeting all the characters and learning about their little quirks and how they help each other. We have also been finding out all about wolves and discovered some very interesting facts about them. The children have made information posters and research notes, created character descriptions, written diary entries and thank you letters. They have also been working very hard to improve their handwriting and presentation. This week we welcomed our own little cuddly toy wolves to our class family. They have been cuddled a lot!

In Maths, we have explored Place Value to 100 and are now working on Addition and Subtraction, which we will continue with this after the half term holiday. Whilst in PE we have been learning and playing 20th Century playground games – Tig games, Hopscotch & Sevens (ball games). We have had a lot of fun with this and even started using them at playtime!

The children have been learning about the United Kingdom and finding out about each of the countries, their flags, language and speciality foods. They have been using their senses in our Science activities, researching animals, exploring different animal groups and their features, and grouping animals based on their diet.
