PUPIL PREMIUM HELPS FAMILIES & SCHOOL!

Although the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, automatically receive a free school meal under the Government's Universal scheme, if you get any of the [qualifying benefits](#) school can get extra funding, called Pupil Premium, if you [apply](#) with LCC.

Families of children in any year group can be eligible for PP. We use the PP

funding to support the children with additional support in class, subsidise school trips and clubs etc.

We currently have over 20% of our school family who are entitled to PP.
