Hello, it has been a busy couple of weeks in Class 4! We enjoyed reminiscing about Year 5/6's trip to Borwick and presenting our memories in a special worship at the start of this week. We have been celebrating British Science Week as a school and celebrated our learning in a lovely worship on Thursday this week. We learnt all about bioluminescent creatures and how they use their glow for a number of different purposes. It was fantastic to see the learning from Reception to Year 6!

In Maths, we have been continuing our work on short division, moving on to looking at fractions this week. In English, we started our new novel; "The Butterfly Lion" by Michael Morpurgo.
