<b>Disciplinary Knowledge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Talk about the feelings associated with giving and receiving gifts.</li> <li>Retell the nativity story in two parts, a) the shepherds and b) the wise men.</li> <li>Talk about giving gifts that are not objects.</li> </ul>	<b>Markers for Assessment for Disciplinary Knowledge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To explain how they feel when they receive a gift</li> <li>To explain the story from different perspectives</li> </ul>		
<b>Prior Substantive Knowledge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For Christians Christmas is the celebration of Jesus' birthday.</li> <li>Jesus was a very special baby. Christians believe he was the Son of God.</li> <li>The church celebrates Christmas in special ways.</li> <li>Diwali is Hindu festival of light celebrated in the Autumn.</li> </ul>	<b>Vocabulary</b> <b>Values:</b> Love, Generosity and Thankfulness  Investigate, empathise, reflect Gift Wise Men Magi Jesus Promise		
<b>Prior Disciplinary Knowledge</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recall/retell the nativity story.</li> <li>Identify the characters in the nativity story.</li> <li>Talk about why Christmas is important, how it is celebrated in the church and their own experiences</li> <li>Talk about the Hindu Diwali festival celebrations.</li> <li>Recall the story of Rama and Sita and identify the characters.</li> </ul>	<b>Cross-Curricular/Enrichment</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Art – Christmas Art</li> <li>Geography – Christmas around the world</li> <li>PHSE – How we are all unique; diversity of celebrations across the globe</li> <li>English – Retelling the story, diary entries, thought, feel, speak bubbles, dramatisation</li> </ul>		
<b>Questions (potential 'hook' questions for lessons)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Why do people give and receive gifts at Christmas?</li> <li>Why is Jesus described as a gift?</li> <li>How does it feel when you give and receive gifts?</li> <li>What is the best gift you have ever received?</li> </ul>
