Reception

In Literacy we have been learning how to write short 3 and 4 letter words, listening carefully for the sounds. We have been trying to write our daily letter sound accurately, thinking where the grapheme starts and finishes. In Maths we have learned how to recognise and describe circles & triangles. We went on a hunt around school to search for circles and triangles. This week we are learning how to count 4 and 5. We have looked at the different ways 4 and 5 objects can be laid out, eg 2 on the bottom and 2 on the top makes 4. In RE we listened to the story 'Kipper's Surprise Party' and thought how upset we would feel if someone forgot it was our birthday. We will soon be learning about a Very Special Birthday Indeed!

Year 1

This week we have had lots of fun making a cake and writing the recipe for this. The children had to use their bossy verbs to help them with their writing such as weigh, cream, beat, spread, stir, crack, mix and bake. We have been writing these instructions over the week to try and improve our stamina. In Maths we have been looking at number bonds and using the symbols + and =. Why not ask us to tell you our number bonds to 10? in RE we have started the Christmas story and had to

place the events in order. We are going to start learning our Nativity which will really help us with our RE work this term.
