## Why do Christians believe that Easter is all about love?

Substantive Knowledge:  Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey on Palm Sunday.  Jesus died on the cross on Good Friday.  Christians believe that Jesus rose on Easter Day and is alive today.
