Reading



This half term, I will be looking at the novel, Charlotte's Web by E.B. White. We will explore vocabulary in the book and the characters and settings included.

Writing

I will write my own chapter of the story, innovating some of the information to make it my own. I will be choosing nouns or pronouns appropriately for clarity and cohesion and to avoid repetition. I will practice writing in paragraphs.

Spoken Language

I will use appropriate intonation, tone and volume to present my writing.

Geography – The Lake District

I will identify the Lake District and the area of Cumbria on a map of the United Kingdom. I will learn to name some key features of the Lake District

 including lakes, mountains, hills and towns, I will identify the use of the Lake District and talk about how the uses of the Lake District have an impact both positive and negative. To do this, I will use four points of a compass to identify geographical features.

PE – Gymnastic Activities 1

I will begin to demonstrate travelling actions on PHYSICAL feet, and hands and feet. I will learn to show balances in front and back support positions and demonstrate the dish and arch shape. I will start to combine travelling, jumping and balancing actions and demonstrate basic rolling actions. I will gain confidence to demonstrate balance on one foot and arabesque and create and demonstrate a gymnastics sequence of 6 actions. Finally, I will plan and perform a simple sequence including travel, rolling, balance and jumping.

DT – Mechanical Systems

Through research and discovery, I will learn to explain how existing products have incorporated mechanical systems to create movement. I will then incorporate new skills/mechanisms into a final product. I will then adapt my product to improve it further. I should grow in confidence to try different ideas.

RE - Harvest/ Sukkot - Judaism

I will learn that harvest is celebrated throughout the world by people of all faiths and none. I will find out that harvest is mentioned throughout the Old Testament and there is a connection between Christian belief and behaviour in relation to celebrating the harvest. I will discover why God's people in the Old Testament brought their first fruits and finest grain. As part of our work on global faiths, I will learn about the key features of the Jewish festival of Sukkot. I will talk about what the Harvest Festival and being thankful means to me and explain what my first and finest offerings would be.

Science – Living Things and their Habitats

I will learn to name living things living in two different habitats, giving the key features that helped me to identify them. I will be able to give three examples of how an environment may change both naturally and due to human impact following my learning. I will learn to work scientifically and keep a careful record of living things found in different habitats throughout the year using recording techniques such as diagrams, tally charts etc. I will learn to use classification keys to identify unknown plants and animals.



Computing – Branching Databases

I will learn to create questions with yes/no answers. I will identify attributes and collect data.

I will create a branching database. I will also plan this first if I am in Year 4.

I will plan and create an identification tool with some support.





Music

I will learn about sea shanties, including the words to 'What shall we do with the drunken sailor?' I will compose body percussion patterns to accompany the song and learn the song expressively and sing it in unison.
