

Class Open Door







Class News

In Year 1...

We celebrated British Science Week this week and have explored in depth the many wonderful qualities of Dandelions!! The children were shocked to discover the nutritional value of the humble dandelion and its' history. We hunted the dandelions, made observational drawings and looked at the life cycle. In Maths we have continued with learning our numbers to 50 and have been working on 1 more and 1 less.

In Year 2 ...

This week we have been completed our work on multiplication and division and have explored the links between multiplication and division facts. We have begun our new topic on measures and have been measuring in centimetres using a ruler.

Please keep practising x2, x5 and x10 tables with your child. We will be revisiting them every week. Next week, your child will be tested on their recall of the x5 tables – please practise with them. We have enjoyed our first Simon Bartram story – Man on the Moon (A Day in the life of Bob) and the children have been making predictions, collecting interesting vocabulary and writing descriptions of their rockets.

We have been looking at how we celebrate Easter with our families and in school and begun to explore some Easter traditions and symbols.

In our Science, we have been looking in detail at the different trees, their shapes, buds and barks. We even made bark rubbings! We have also been experimenting with recycling glass bottles to make musical instruments as part of our learning for British Science Week.

We explored how changing the amount of water in a vessel changed the sound when struck lightly with a pencil. We created our own music!
