Non-Fiction - Non - Chronological Reports: Based on animals from a range of habitats. (3 weeks)	 Use present tense for non-chronological reports and persuasive adverts. Select, generate and effectively use nouns.
Spellings Grammar	 Little Wandle spelling programme Prefix (Adding 'un' in front of a word) How it changes the meaning of verbs and adjectives. e.g. unkind, untie Use of 'ly' to turn adjective into adverbs. Using 'a' or 'an' according to whether the next word begins with a consonant or a vowel
