

Each day we are choosing 4 children who have demonstrated something to be proud of, to take a turn with the buddies.

Before Half Term, we enjoyed activities linked to National Storytelling week, where we wrote a whole school story. Mr Pratley came to share a story with us in Class.

As a class we wrote 3 books; Our Favourite Stories, Our Inventions and Our How to be Happy Book.

We have started looking at Fact Files in English this week. In Maths we are w-now working on numbers to 50 and have been practising counting in 10s.

In Year 2 ...

Welcome back! We hope you have all had a good rest over the half term. Before the holidays, we enjoyed National Storytelling week and in class we explored the Aliens love Underpants and the related stories in the series by Claire Freedman and Ben Cort. Writing activities included designing our own aliens; writing diary entries about dinosaurs as cavemen; creating treasure maps and instructions for the pirates to find the golden underpants and describing the dragons attacking King Top Bot's castle. Phew! What a busy week!

This week we have been exploring the concept of division and sharing into equal groups, practised our x10 tables and worked with the x2 table. The children have brought home a copy of their tables to practise for next week's test.

We have been writing descriptions of the Cave of Wonders and written our own versions of the Genie's song – You'll never have a friend like me! We have been using verbs ending with _ing and shared what a good friend does.

We have completed our topic about 'Jesus, friend to all', in RE, and will begin learning about Easter next week.

In our Science, we have explored sustainability this week and looked at ways in which we can recycle materials and protect trees to combat climate change.

Next week, we will complete our work relating to the story of Aladdin before exploring the 'Man on the Moon' series of books by Simon Bartram.
