In Year 1...

We were very proud of the children’s re writing of The Enormous Turnip, we had Giant Strawberries and Monstrous Pumpkins to name just a few. We were encouraged with the use of finger spaces, full stops and capital letters. Our focus next week will be letter formation and handwriting as we explore different stories in National Storytelling Week. *Please can children bring in their favourite story next week.*

In Maths we have been looking at counting on up to 20 and using number bonds to 20.

In RE we have just finished the story of Joseph and talked about how God was with him during his time in Egypt and how he showed forgiveness to his brothers.

In Year 2 ...

This week in maths we have been continuing to learn about money. We have been making amounts using coins to match a given amount and begun finding change. We have turned our roleplay area into a shop!

Next week we begin our unit on Multiplication and Division and the children have been exploring counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Our first times table will be focusing on is the x10 table.

Our RE lessons have explored the stories of blind Bartimaeus and the Ten Lepers. We have considered how their lives were changed by meeting Jesus.

In Science, we have been recording the weather and looking at the different types of weather. We have been exploring how weather affects our actions and begun creating our own weather reports.

Next week, it is National Story Telling week and the children will be taking part in different story related activities over the week.
