Poetry: Rhyming poems Eg Commotion in the Ocean (2 weeks) Non-fiction:	 Write in different forms with simple text type features e.g. instructions, narratives, recounts, poems, information texts. Read aloud their writing audibly to adults and peers. Sequence ideas and events in non-fiction.
Adverts for a farm (2 weeks) Additional non-fiction unit: Fact files (around animals) (2 weeks)	 Use the joining word and to link words and clauses.
