Class 4 Behaviour Expectations

In Class 4, the children have created and signed a behaviour agreement which will be followed in class at all times. Team points are used as our positive behaviour strategy in class and children are all in the same house teams as last year. The children can also earn table points which will be counted and team points for this are given on a Friday.

Homework

Your child will have weekly homework that is due every Thursday. This gives us chance to mark it and stick the next homework in, ready for Friday. Spellings should be practiced every night, as well as times tables. Reading books should be read at least 3 times per

week. This can be completed by your child. We will often communicate using the reading diary to enhance your child's reading experience, so please check this weekly.

Handwriting

Handwriting is a big focus this year. Please ensure your child is writing using the cursive handwriting model, they may use language such as "lead in and lead out". For any support with this, please feel free to pop in and see me.

School Website

Please keep an eye on the school website for all of the information you will need regarding your child's education. Mrs Seagrave and I upload newsletters bi-weekly which have updates and key information on them. Uniform
