We've had a fabulous few weeks in Class 4. The children have been working hard in all areas of the curriculum. In English, they have been writing their own versions of Lucy's journey through the wardrobe in 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe'. In maths, they have been looking at the place value of numbers to 100,000 (Y4) and up to 1 million (Y5). They have also been rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, as well as looking at negative numbers. Ask your child about the rounding rule! In Geography, we have been learning how to read maps and how to use 4 and 6 figure grid references. Thank you to all of those who were able to join us at our Autumn Praise last week, the children loved performing "The Harvest Samba".
